# **Gladys C. Pulliam**

**G**ladys C. Pulliam, 86, of Culpeper, died Sunday, August 13, 2006 at Autumn Care of Madison. She was born January 12, 1920 to the late Christopher Columbus and Ruth V. Clatterbuck.

Mrs. Pulliam served as magistrate for Culpeper County for forty years and was in charge of the Rationing Board during World War II. In addition to assisting her husband with their insurance and real estate agency, she was a very active Den Mother to many Cub Scouts including several of today's very prominent community members. She was a member of the New Salem Baptist Church.
