Sidney Armistead Park, a Fluvanna County resident for 28 years, passed away on October 11, 2008, at his home in Palmyra, Va.

Sidney Park was born April 9, 1926, in The Plains, in Fauquier County, Va. and spent his early life in Prince William County. Sidney served in the Coast Guard during World War II. After his marriage to his childhood sweetheart, Ann Summers Lightner, Sidney moved to Annandale in Fairfax County. He was the owner and operator of Park Brothers Moving Company for 20 years.

During a drive to visit a friend in Palmyra, Sidney and Ann missed a turn ending up in front of a yellow farm house which was for sale. They were enamored with the idea of living in the country and purchased the house. Sidney then retired in 1980, moving to Palmyra with his wife and son, Phillip.
