She was also a good seamstress, making many school clothes for her daughter as well as alterations for several family members and friends. She also made crafts, like stuffed animals and dolls.

She is survived by her daughter, Jean Hawkins Bryant Payne of Culpeper; one sister, Rachel Ada Jenkins of Manassas; her special niece and nephew, Rachel Ann Fleury and Jack Elmo Hawkins; and a host of other nieces and nephews.
